Notification

- ① Only certified scuba diving instructors are allowed to give guidance to inexperienced divers and no more than 8 divers with 1 instructor.
- ② Be aware of the local underwater contour, current, and tidal change.
- ③ Guidance by dive instructor/master is required when diving in a new/unfamiliar waters.
- ④ Prevent from separation and no solo dive. Staying with the buddy/group when getting in and out of water.
- ⑤ Dive operation should be canceled when the local weather and sea condition are not cooperated.
- ⑥ No diving when having physical or mental illness.
- ⑦ Plan your repeated dive.
- ⑧ Do not fly 24 hrs. after your last dive.
- ⑨ Surface signaling devices are mandatory for both boat and shore diving.


Water activities Safety Guideline



Pre-Activity

Participants

- Select qualified service providers (registration or insurance documents)
※ Official on-line website and QR code scanning are also available.
- Follow the introduction and notification from instructors.
- Surrounding environment and diving range.
- Physical and mental health for diving.
- Learn and conduct the buddy system.
- Ensure the instruments/gears are functional.
- Qualified instructors are required.
- Agree on underwater communication hand signs .



Service Providers

- To know the local weather conditions (wind, current, and tide etc....)
- Site survey and to determine the entering and exiting points.
- Plan you dive and dive your plan.
- Introduction to the equipment, demonstration of the activity, and safety education.
- Surface signaling devices.
- Pre-dive briefing: agree on the div plan.
- To establish a dive flag for divers the surface.



During-Activity


Participants

- Follow the instructor(s) and stay with the group. Keeping your buddy by your side for the entire diving activity.
- Collecting marine creatures, touching any unknown or dangerous
- marine life, and damaging coral reefs are not allowed.



Service Providers

- Make sure all gears are functional before getting in to the water.
- Be aware of the participants; prevent them from left behind.
- Following the depth limitation and precaution decompression procedure.
- Periodical head count; ensure grouped.



Post-Activity

Participants

- Return all equipment.
- Do not leave your personal belongings and trash behind.



Service Providers

- Counting heads and gears.
- Recording your air consumption.
- To rinse, maintain all diving gears and proper storage.
- Post-dive briefing and troubleshooting.
